This, in part, is so that other citizens who may have the same concern may also be involved in the discussion.

Discuss and consider approval of a resolution accepting and confirming the canvassing of election returns, including the returns of early voting ballots cast in connection therewith, and accepting the declaration of the results of both the General and Special Municipal Elections held May 2, 2026, for the purpose of electing three council members – one each for Places 2, 4 and 6 - each for a two-year term and for the consideration of certain amendments to the City Charter; accepting issuance of certificates of election; accepting issuance of the canvass of both the general and special municipal elections held May 2, 2026, and taking any action necessary.

RESOLUTION NO. 26-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL, TEXAS, ACCEPTING AND CONFIRMING THE CANVASSING OF ELECTION RETURNS, INCLUDING THE RETURNS OF EARLY VOTING BALLOTS CAST IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, AND ACCEPTING THE DECLARATION OF THE RESULTS OF BOTH THE GENERAL AND SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS HELD MAY 2, 2026, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THREE COUNCILMEMBERS – ONE EACH FOR PLACES 2, 4 AND 6 - EACH FOR A TWO-YEAR TERM AND FOR THE CONSIDERATION OF CERTAIN AMENDMENTS TO THE CITY CHARTER; ACCEPTING ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES OF ELECTION; ACCEPTING ISSUANCE OF THE CANVASS OF BOTH THE GENERAL AND SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS HELD MAY 2, 2026; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on February 2, 2026, the City Council of the City of Rockwall, Texas (hereinafter referred to as the "City") passed and approved Resolution No. 26-04 and Resolution No. 26-05, which ordered a General Municipal Election (hereinafter referred to as the "General Municipal Election") and a Special Election to be held on May 2, 2026, for the purpose of electing three (3) Council Members – one each for Places 2, 4 and 6, each for two-year terms and for consideration of certain amendments to the city's Home Rule Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Rockwall has heretofore caused to be posted and published in accordance with the election laws of the State of Texas, notices of the General Municipal Election and Special (Charter Amendments) Election, each held on May 2, 2026, and the Rockwall City Secretary has obtained newspaper affidavits of the posting and publication of the notices of each of these elections, as reflected in "**Exhibit A**" of this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter of the City of Rockwall was adopted in January 1985, and amended five times, the last time in May 2015. In accordance with Section 11.15 of the Rockwall City Charter, the City Council appointed a Charter Review Commission to determine whether any Charter provisions require revision and such Section of the Charter requires a review of the Charter every five years; and

WHEREAS, the Charter Review Commission met from December 2024 through February 2025 to review the City Charter and the Commission finalized its report of its findings in writing, and presented its proposed amendments to the City Council in March 2025; and

WHEREAS, on February 2, 2026 and pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 9.004, the Rockwall City Council submitted on its own motion proposed charter amendments to the voters for their approval at a municipal election; and

WHEREAS, the General Municipal Election and Special Election were duly and legally held on May 2, 2026, in the City and in conformity with the election laws of the State of Texas, and the results of each of these elections, including the early voting results, have been certified and returned by the proper administrator, judges and clerks thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Secretary, acting as general custodian of the election records,

presented the official returns of the presiding judge of the elections, including the returns of early voting ballots cast in connection therewith, to the Canvassing Board; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Rockwall, acting in its capacity as the Canvassing Board, has considered the returns of said elections, including the returns of early voting ballots cast in connection therewith at its special-called City Council Meeting held May 11, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. at Rockwall City Hall, said date being in accordance with Section 67.003 Texas Election Code; and

WHEREAS, the returns of each municipal election, including the returns of early voting ballots cast in connection therewith, duly and legally made, showed the total valid and legal votes and results, as reflected in the body of this resolution and in the attached “**Exhibit B**” to this resolution, which were read into the record and thereafter canvassed by the Canvassing Board on May 11, 2026; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law and Section 5.04(1) of the City Charter, the candidate for elective office receiving a plurality of the votes cast will be declared the winner of the General Election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKWALL, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. INCORPORATION OF PREMISES. That all of the above premises are found and determined to be true and correct and are incorporated into the body of this resolution as if copied in their entirety.

SECTION 2. CONFIRMATION OF VOTE TABULATIONS. That it is further found and determined that the results of the General Municipal Election and Special Election, as tabulated and reflected in this resolution, including “**Exhibit B**” of this resolution, are approved and hereby canvassed by the Canvassing Board on May 11, 2026 during a special Rockwall City Council meeting, and that they reflect the expressed desires of the resident, qualified electors of the City of Rockwall.

SECTION 3. ELECTED OFFICIALS; TERMS OF OFFICE. That the official results regarding votes cast for each City Council candidate race are as follows:

SECTION 6. A majority of the residents, qualified electors of the City of Rockwall, Texas, voting in the election, have **voted FOR the adoption of Charter Amendment Propositions One, Two, Three, Four, Five, Six and Seven.** The Council hereby determines that such propositions were approved, that the election was duly called, proper notice given, and that the election was held in all aspects in conformity with the law.

SECTION 7. The Charter propositions approved by the voters will be effective as of the date of this Resolution.

SECTION 8. ISSUANCE OF CANVASS OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION. That the Mayor has executed and delivered the Canvass of both the General Municipal Election and Special Municipal Election in accordance with the election laws of the State of Texas.

SECTION 9. The recitals contained in the preamble hereof are hereby found to be true, and such recitals are hereby made a part of this Resolution for all purposes and are adopted as a part of the judgment and findings of the City Council.

SECTION 10. If any provision of this resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this resolution and the application of such provision to other persons and circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and the City Council hereby declares that this resolution would have been enacted without such invalid provision.

SECTION 11. DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and it is accordingly so resolved.
